PAINTING OVER GRAFFITI

Martin and Emily have pulled together a team to paint over graffiti on painted surfaces or rendered walls. Below is our list of walls that will be painted over. Are there any walls that we have missed?

The walls will be covered in anti-graffiti paint that closely matches the colour of the present surface. Any further graffiti on these surfaces will come off either in the rain or with some soap and water.

- rendered wall on the side of 71 Silver Street – graffiti faces Silverfield Close
- side of 12 Silver Street (furniture shop) – graffiti faces Aldi car park
- side of the Acorns Charity Shop at the corner of High Street and Silver Street – graffiti faces Silver Street
- front of Seager Bearing – corner of Addison Road and Goldsmith Road
- painted garage door to the rear of 85b Blenheim Road – garage door faces Clarence Road
- painted surface of 137 School Road – City Clipper barbers
- doors of Council owned garages across the road from 41 Middleton Road
- wall at side of York Rd Café, 16 York Road
- wall at side of 'Kind Barbers' 31 Poplar Road
- wall at side of AA Jewellers, 16 Poplar Road
- front of Ruprai Wines, corner of Station Road and Westfield Road
- painted surface on the side of 2 Prospect Road – graffiti faces School Road
